**TIME TO CHANGE OUR CLOCKS!** Spring ahead one hour. Daylight Savings time begins earlier this year. Time changes at 2:00 a.m. on Sunday March 11, 2007. Since 1966, most of the United States has observed Daylight Savings Time from 2:00 a.m. on the first Sunday of April to 2:00 a.m. on the last Sunday of October. Beginning in 2007, most of the U.S. will begin Daylight Savings Time at 2:00 a.m. on the second Sunday in March and revert to standard time on the first Sunday in November.



## Town Council Update

The Town Council approved the following during the February 13th & 27th, 2007 Meetings:

- Second and final Reading of Ordinance #07-01 - Regulation of aircraft from taking off or landing within the limits of the Town of Lake Clarke Shores.
- Resolution #07-03 – Proclaiming the “2006 Volunteer of the Year”
- Resolution #07-04 – Expressing opposition to House Bill 529 which prohibits municipalities and counties from negotiating terms and conditions from cable and video providers wishing to do business within the local governments’ jurisdiction in the future.
- Approval of Palm Beach County District 3 Recreation Assistance Program Funding for Lake Clarke Shores Community Park in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.
- Approval of Palm Beach County District 3 Recreation Assistance Program for Lake Clarke Shores 50th Anniversary Events in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.
- Approval to proceed with request for bid on final plans for Bathroom Facilities at LCS Community Park.
- Approval of Pavilion for Lake Clarke Shores Community Park in the amount of \$19,109.25

## CODE ENFORCEMENT

*Just a friendly reminder...*

***Vegetation is picked up on Mondays.***

Town code states that vegetation cannot be placed at curbside prior to SATURDAY MORNING. Code Enforcement issues a Notice of Violation for placing vegetation out earlier than this.

The Town's contract with Waste Management does not include removal of yard waste (vegetation) that has been cut or trimmed by anyone other than the owner or tenant of the property. If you have a LAWN MAINTENANCE person or company, they MUST remove the yard waste that they generate.

Crime Report



The total number of offenses reported for 2006 was 49. This was up slightly over 2005 when we had only 43 events. However, in the past three years, we have had a large decrease in our number of offenses. In 2002 we reported 85 offenses and in 2003 we reported 84 offenses. That's equivalent to approximately a 41% decrease in our overall offense rate.



With the exception of the December surge of residential burglaries, experienced by the entire county, our crime trends have continued to decrease overall.
