FEMA NEWS

Your home is one of the biggest investments that you have. One of the most important things that you do to protect your home is to purchase homeowners insurance. But, did you know that your homeowner insurance does not cover flood damage? Everyone has some risk of flooding no matter where your property is located. Flood insurance is relatively inexpensive compared to the cost of possible repairs after flood damage has occurred. The Town of Lake Clarke Shores participates in the National Flood Insurance Program administered by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). This means that Town residents are entitled to receive a 5% discount on flood insurance if their property is within a special flood hazard area. It takes 30 days before a flood insurance policy goes into effect. Don't wait to protect your investment - contact your insurance carrier to obtain information on flood insurance.

NPDES



Throwing trash, litter and other refuse from boats or other types of vessels into the waterways is prohibited. It is also against codes to discard debris, vegetation and other items into the waterways from docks, bridges or shorelines. Report illegal dumping to the Lake Clarke Shores Police Department by calling the non-emergency dispatch center at 964-1114. Please do your part to help keep our waterways clean.

Safety Tips For Joggers/Walkers

- Make sure people can see you: Think about where you are going and how well lit it may or may not be. Going out at dusk or at night is dangerous without some type reflective material on your clothing. Many athletic shoes have reflective qualities built in, but also consider a vest complete with reflective tape or a blinking light.

CODE ENFORCEMENT

The Town of Lake Clarke Shores has a reputation for having beautiful homes and well manicured lawns and landscape. While many residents maintain their own lawn and landscape, there are others who hire lawn service or lawn maintenance companies to do the work for them. According to Sec. 14-1 of the Town Code of Ordinances – lawn service / lawn maintenance companies that work within Town limits must register their business with the Town on an annual basis. If you use a lawn service, make sure that the company is currently registered with the Town.

Please note that Code Enforcement will be randomly stopping lawn service / lawn maintenance companies to verify their compliance with this code.

Contact Joan Perron at 964-1515 ext. 14 to make sure the service / company you use is registered with the Town or to obtain a list of companies that are current with their registration.

- Run/walk against traffic so you can observe approaching automobiles.
- Run/walk clear of parked cars or bushes.
- Don't wear headsets. If you wear them you won't hear an approaching car.
- Carry a flashlight.
- Jog or run with a known companion
- Carry a whistle or high decibel battery powered personal alarm device when you jog or run.
