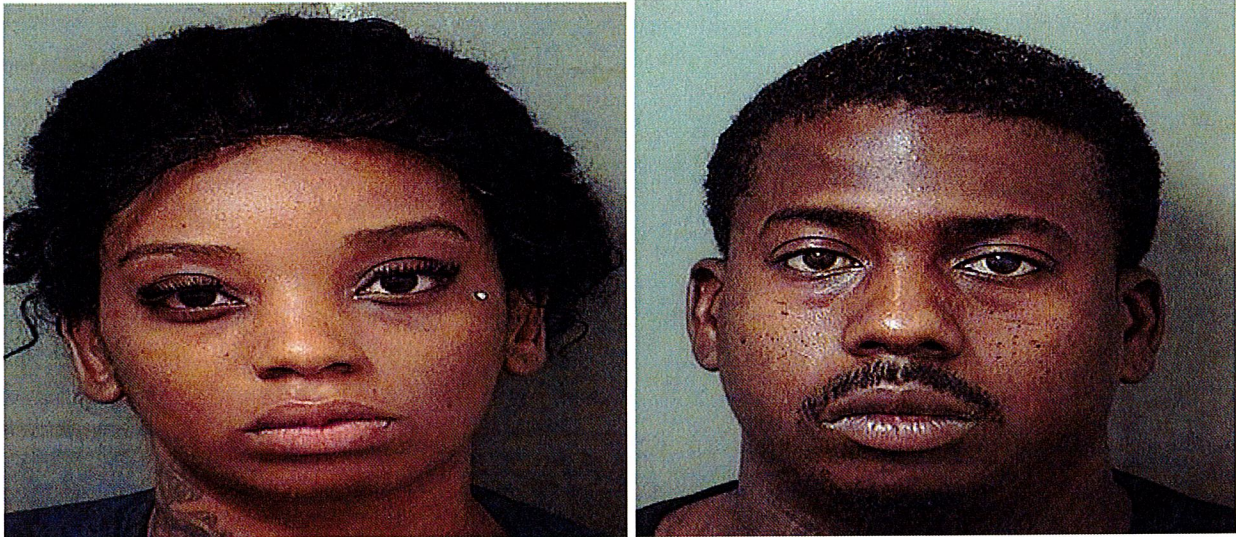

Lake Clarke Shores Police Department Case # 2017-0392

Suspects: Ellerbe, Takina B/F 11/08/91 and King, Brandon, B/M 2/11/84

On 3/8/2017 an Armed Robbery and Kidnapping occurred at 1755 Forest Hill Blvd. Suspect Takina Ellerbe was arrested and charged with Armed Robbery, Kidnapping, Aggravated Assault and Aggravated Battery on March 13, 2017 and her Vehicle was seized for forfeiture by LCSPD.

A Warrant for the second suspect, Brandon Alexander King was walked through the State Attorney's Office and signed by the Judge on 3/15/2017. The search for King was turned over to the United States Marshalls Fugitive task force due to his violent criminal past and circumstances of the case. On 3/16/2017, Members of the U.S. Marshals Fugitive Task Force and Riviera Beach Special Response Team executed a search and arrest warrant at Kings Residence located in Riviera Beach. King was taken into custody after attempting to flee from the residence and is now facing charges of Armed Robbery, Kidnapping, Aggravated Battery, Aggravated Assault and Felon in Possession of a Firearm.
